CONCRETE WORK...

There are various ways our construction industry places concrete. The most conventional is using a 'bucket'. The crane loads the material from the trucks and move it to the designated area, one bucket at a time.

Another method often used involves pumping the concrete. Common pumps used are stationary pumps and pump trucks.

At ZIGG Condos, you will see all of these methods used as approach provide us maximum productivity and help us work as quickly as possible.

...AND NOISE

While concrete work has a schedule; weather, wind, and other variables often impact this work. Once concrete work has started, it typically cannot be interrupted.

The City Noise Bylaw has a provision which exempts this type of work and allows it to proceed past the standard hours, otherwise such projects would come to a relative halt in productivity.

Outside of this concrete work all other work activities will respect the designated work hours.
